SUMMARY: Rogue Wave opens with a mesmerizing underwater panorama, revealing a massive undersea drilling platform deep below the ocean's surface, where two-legged robotic "Jumpers" glide across the sea floor, conducting repairs on the platform's structure. When a delay in returning to the base is announced, a daring and rebellious Jumper pilot named Jake Stone decides to take matters into his own hands by challenging his fellow pilots to an unauthorized race through the dark, foreboding depths. A flashback reveals a young Jake escaping the confines of a domed city, dreaming of freedom beyond its borders, only to face the tragic disappearance of his parents.
